



Quality Grant

What is the Quality Grant?

The Quality Grant is on-going operational funding available to designated New Brunswick Early Learning Centres. The quality grant is designed to support the operators to deliver higher quality services, meet the quality criteria of being a designated centre, and to provide financial support for designated centres to achieve their annual quality improvement plans.

Designated centers will be eligible for an operational quality grant of \$2.50 per preschool space. Funding will be calculated based on the unit size determined by the approved ratios

How do designated centers apply for this fund?

Designated New Brunswick Early Learning Centres will be eligible for this funding by applying to become a designated center. Funding will be provided on a monthly basis to each designated center.

Who will benefit?

Designated New Brunswick Early Learning Centres will have funding available to improve the quality of services they provide to families and to contribute to the sustainability of quality preschool services.

Parents and children will benefit from the investments made by designated centres to improve quality, accessibility and affordability in their facility.

Why is it being done?

As part of the New Brunswick Child Care Review Task Force Report, operators have clearly stated that they want to offer quality services and that quality requires additional investments. In addition, becoming a designated centre has additional quality requirements beyond what is expected of licensed facilities.
