Under section 29 of the *Cannabis Control Act*, the Lieutenant-Governor in Council makes the following Regulation:

Citation

1 This Regulation may be cited as the *General Regulation – Cannabis Control Act*.

Definitions

2 The following definitions apply in this Regulation.

“Act” means the *Cannabis Control Act*. (*Loi*)

“houseboat” means a watercraft or other artificial contrivance used or capable of being used as a means of transportation on water that contains sanitary facilities and the necessary facilities for sleeping and the preparation and serving of meals. (*caravane flottante*)

Private dwellings

3(1) The following places are prescribed for the purposes of the definition “private dwelling” in section 2 of the Act:

- (a) a houseboat that is moored, anchored, beached or docked; and
- (b) a guest room of a hotel, motel, inn or bed and breakfast facility where smoking is permitted under the *Smoke-free Places Act*.

3(2) Despite paragraph (1)(a), a houseboat is not a private dwelling when used as a means of public transportation.

Identification documents

4 The following government-issued identification documents are prescribed for the purposes of subsection 8(1) of the Act:

- (a) a driver’s licence;
- (b) a passport; or
- (c) any other document that contains a person’s name, signature, photograph and date of birth.
