We invite you to join the NB Public Libraries' team! You will work in a fun-filled environment, while engaging in meaningful and challenging work. NB public libraries are places where people of all ages and backgrounds gather to pursue their educational, social, and recreational needs.

**What You Will Do:**

The NB Public Libraries' team is looking for candidates to fill a variety of Summer Reading Club (SRC) Activity Leader positions. You will work with children, be creative, and plan experiences that encourage the love of reading.

Some of your duties will include promoting the SRC during class visits, planning and delivering activities for children, and helping children and their caregivers find books and other library materials.

Do you have a background or interest in library service, childcare, or teaching? We would love to have you join our amazing team!

**Note:** Library work involves lifting and standing for long periods of time. Some travel may also be necessary. You will be required to obtain a criminal record check for work with the vulnerable sector.

**Work Environment:**

- 36.25 hours/week, including evenings, and weekends.
- We promote a scent-reduced environment.

**Who You Are:**

You are someone who enjoys reading, learning, and creating. You like working with the public. You are a self-starter and can work independently or as part of a team. You are organized, friendly, and a good communicator. You have a strong knowledge of the Microsoft Office suite.

Previous paid or volunteer work with children, video production experience, and other technological skills are considered assets.

**Your attitude, skills, and interests are just as important as your education. We are looking for diverse backgrounds that bring a combination of the following:**

**Need to Have:**

- You are a resident of New Brunswick or a First Nation community in New Brunswick.
- You are eligible to work in Canada.
- You have a high school diploma\*

**\*Note:** Students entering Grade 12 in the fall may be considered if we have difficulty recruiting for these positions.

Some positions require spoken competence in English and French. Other positions require spoken competence in either English or in French only. Please state your language capability.

**Wage:** \$17.00 per hour
