

The Board may issue a Certificate of Qualification to an individual who

- is the holder of a valid diploma of apprenticeship issued under the *Apprenticeship and Occupational Certification Act*, or
- has the required practical experience for the occupation and has successfully passed the examination for a certificate of qualification, or
- is the holder of a valid certificate of qualification from another province or territory in Canada, and
- provides the required supporting documentation as established by the Director.

Individuals applying to challenge the certification examination must provide documentation to prove that twenty percent (20%) of the practical work experience required for the occupation has been gained within the six (6) years prior to the date of submission of application.
