

2016-2017 APPLICANT CHECKLIST

You should read the *Information Guide* located on the Student Financial Services website at studentaid.gnb.ca to get updated information on funding programs available and how eligibility is determined.

To apply for funding, the following information is required.

- Your Social Insurance Number.
- The Social Insurance Number of your parent(s), sister(s) and/or brother(s) for dependent students, or your partner's Social Insurance Number for married/common-law students.
- Your mailing address where you want to receive your mail from Student Financial Services.
- A permanent address if it is different from your mailing address or next of kin.
- The amounts from lines 114, 119, 121, 129, 130, 150, 210, 230 and 303 of your latest New Brunswick Income Tax Return.
- The amounts from lines 150, 210, 230, 303, 308 or 310, 312, 435 of your parent(s) latest New Brunswick Income Tax Return for dependent students OR lines 114, 119, 121, 129, 150, 210, 230 and 303 of your partner's latest New Brunswick Income Tax Return for married/common-law students.
- Any other income information. For example, an estimate of your summer income and income from your study period, if applicable.
- Information about the educational institution you plan to attend:
 - name, address and telephone number,
 - name of your program of study,
 - start and end dates of your program of study,
 - start and end dates of your co-op work term or practicum, if applicable.
- A password (which you must keep) if applying on-line.
