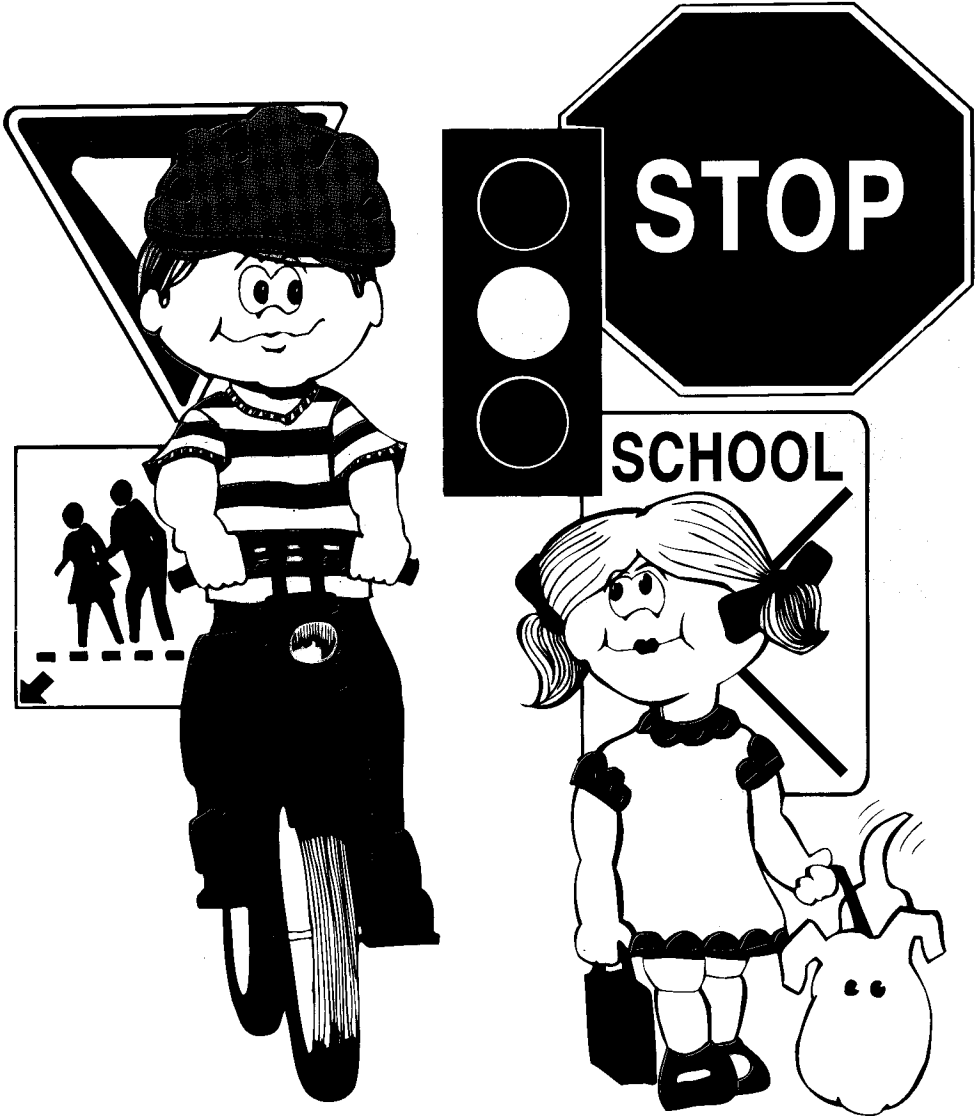
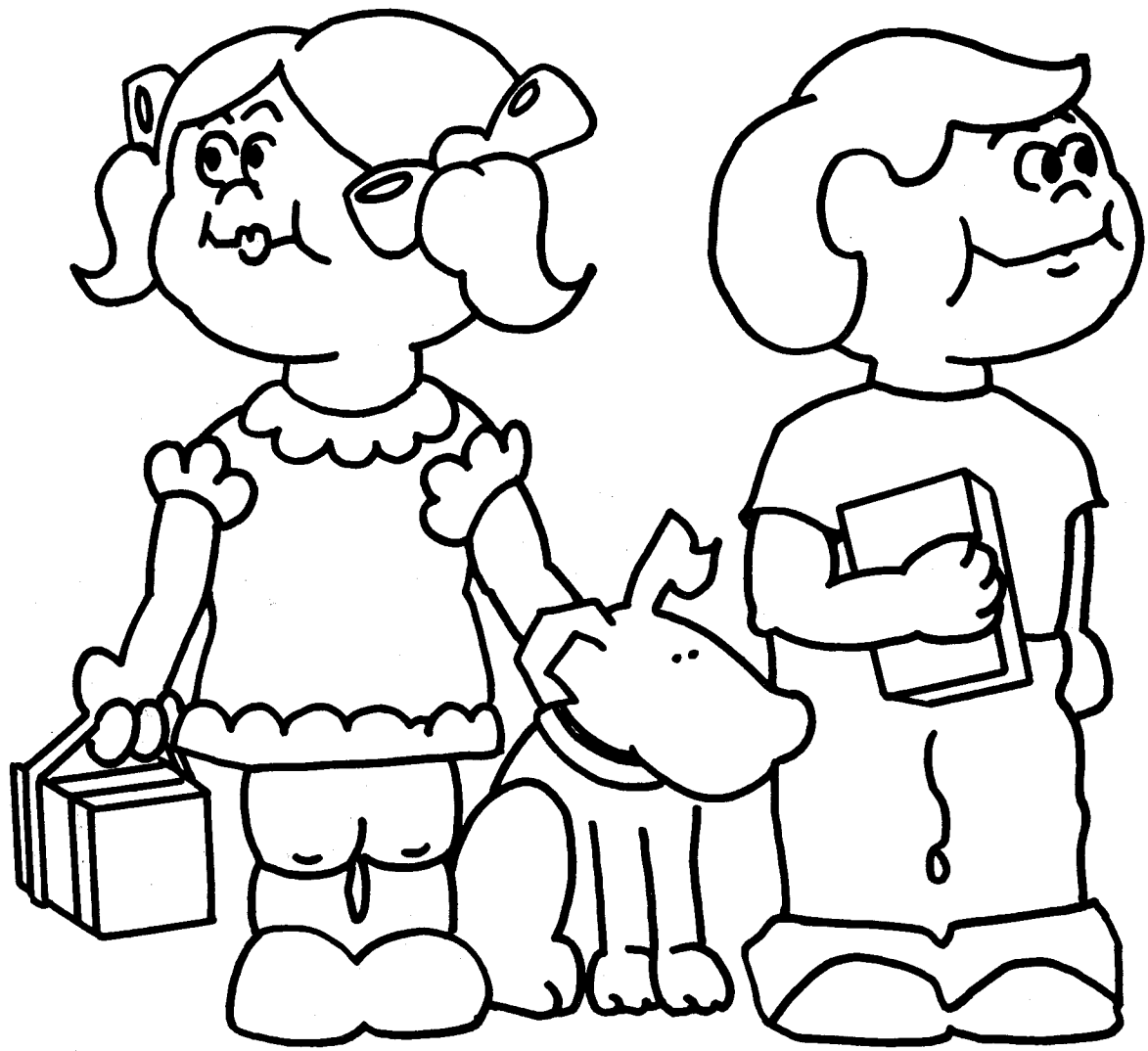

Level 1 Play it Safe Program





Think! Before you cross; Stop, look and listen. Check in every direction before you cross the road. Always look for hidden cars.

Even if cars have stopped, look at the drivers' eyes to know they see you. Keep eye contact as you walk past each car. Keep your arm out until you are safely across.

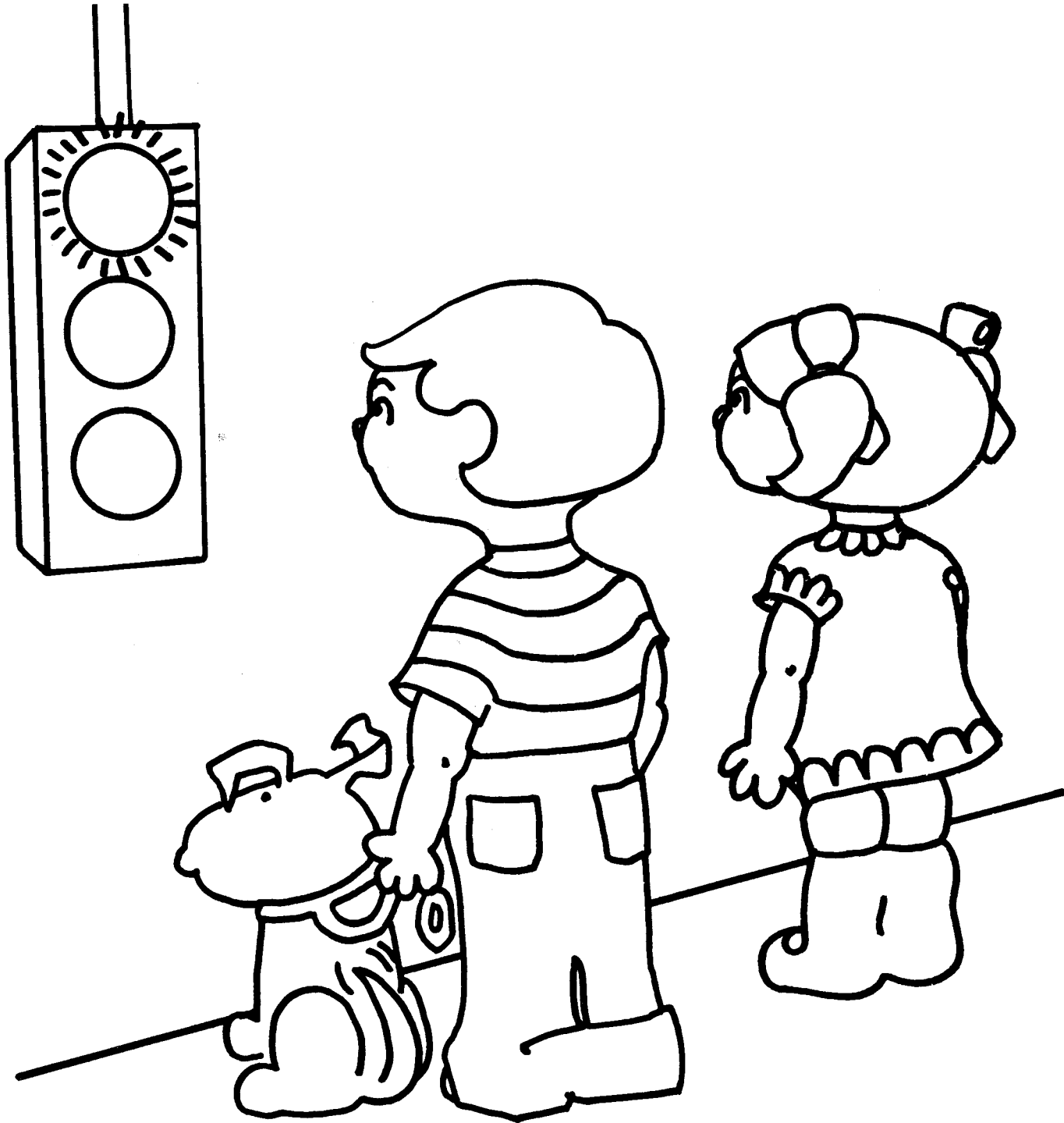
Drivers may not see the signs. Be sure the drivers see you. Put out your arm and point across the street. This tells the drivers of the cars what you would like to do. Know the signs, when to stop and when to go. Walk quickly, but don't run when crossing the street.



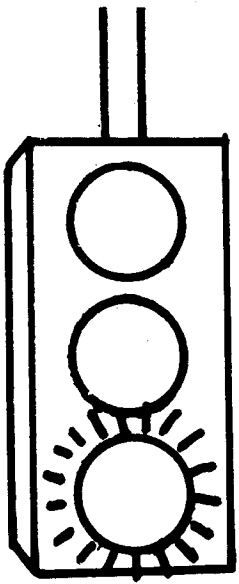
The sidewalk is the safe place
for your tricycle or wagon.



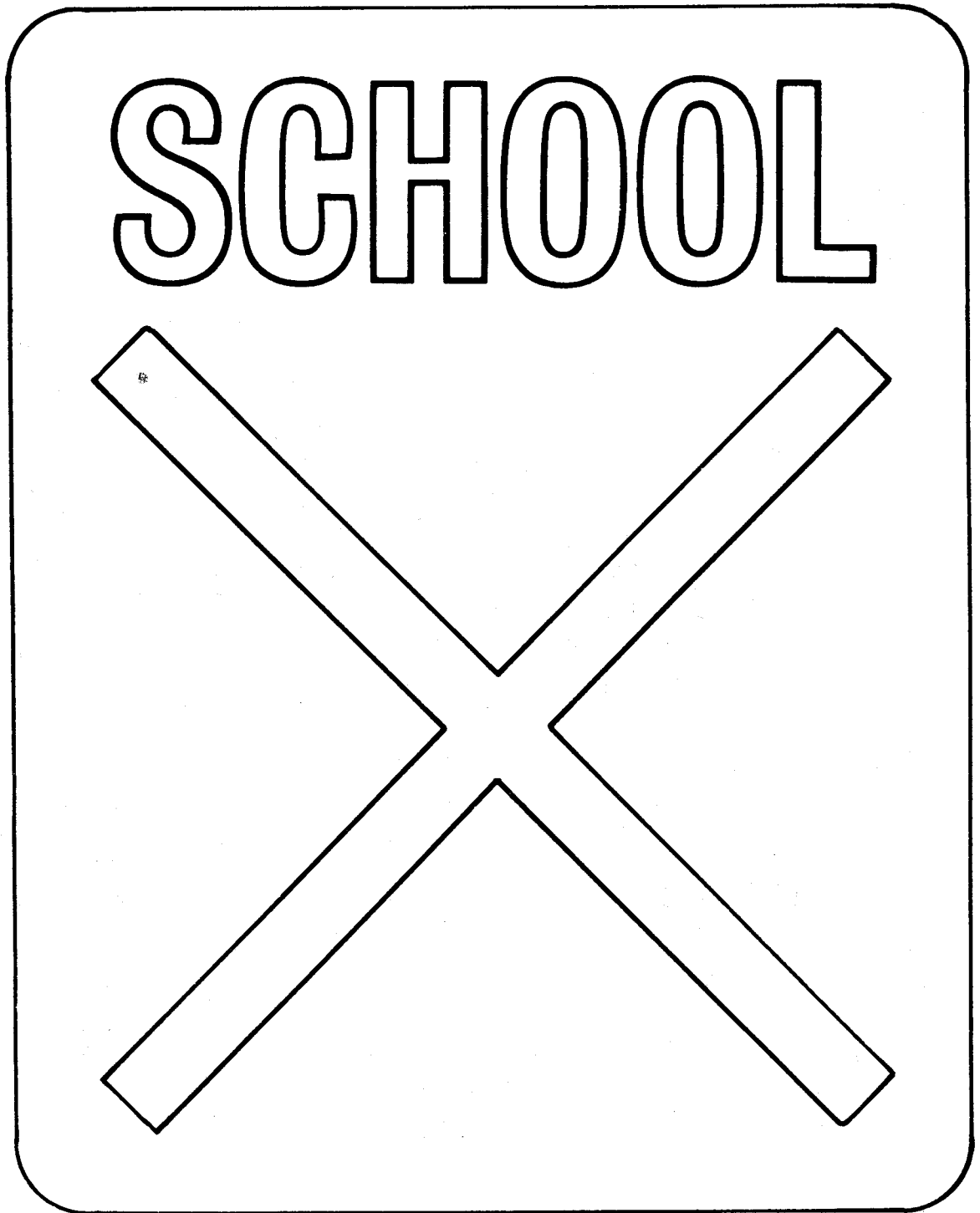
The school crossing guard will help you cross busy streets.



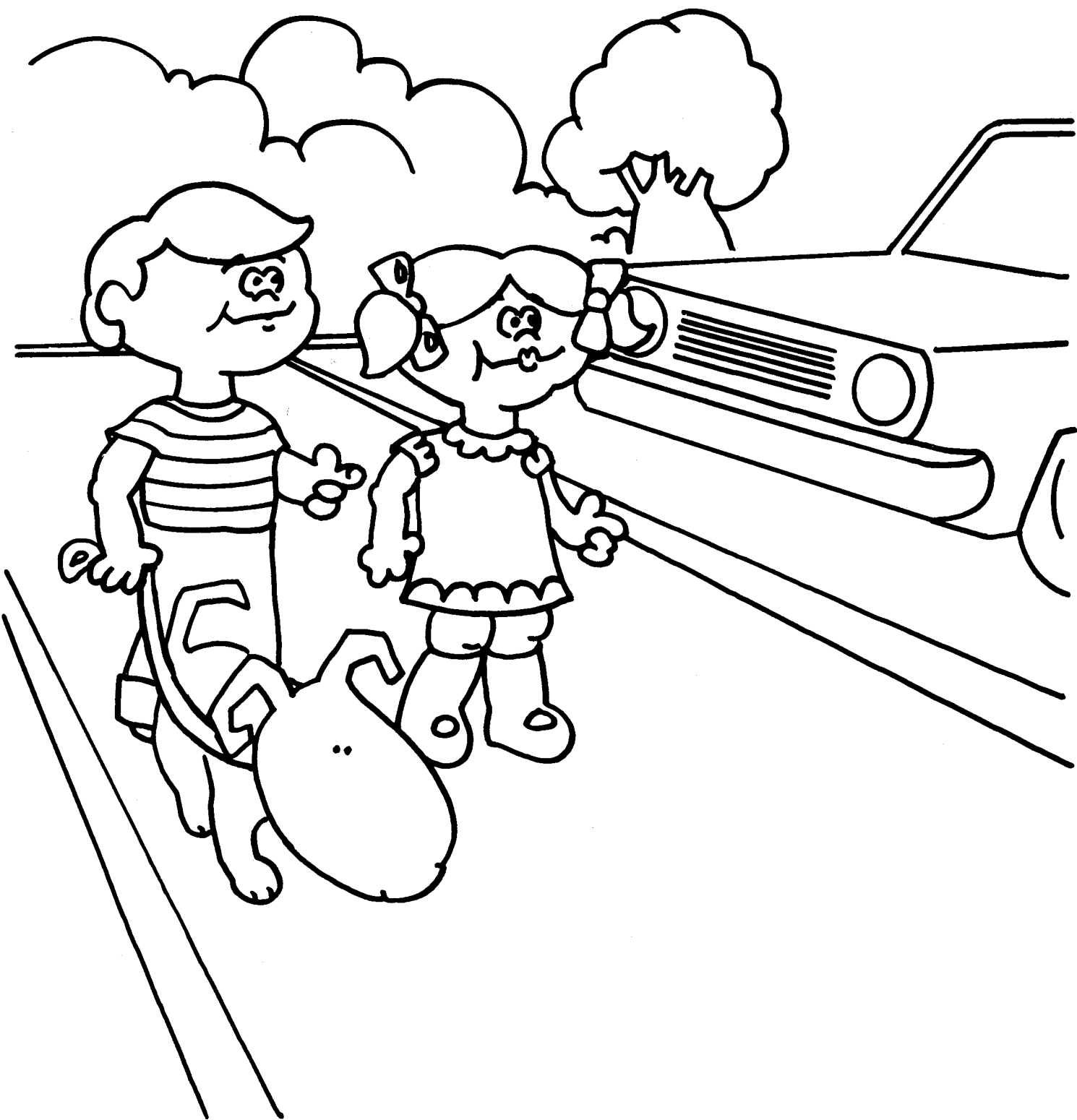
When the light is red, stop.



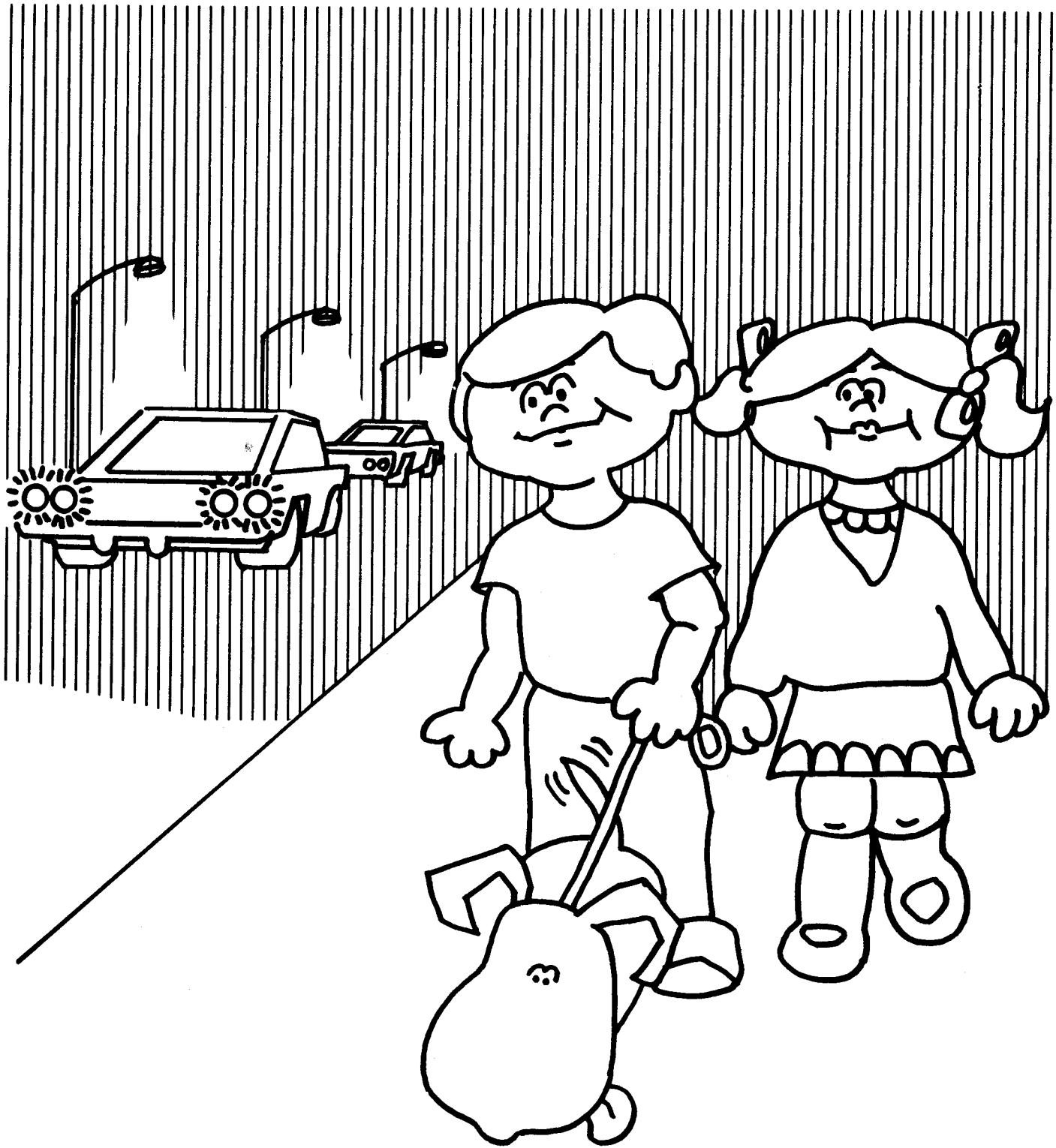
When it turns green, go when it is safe.



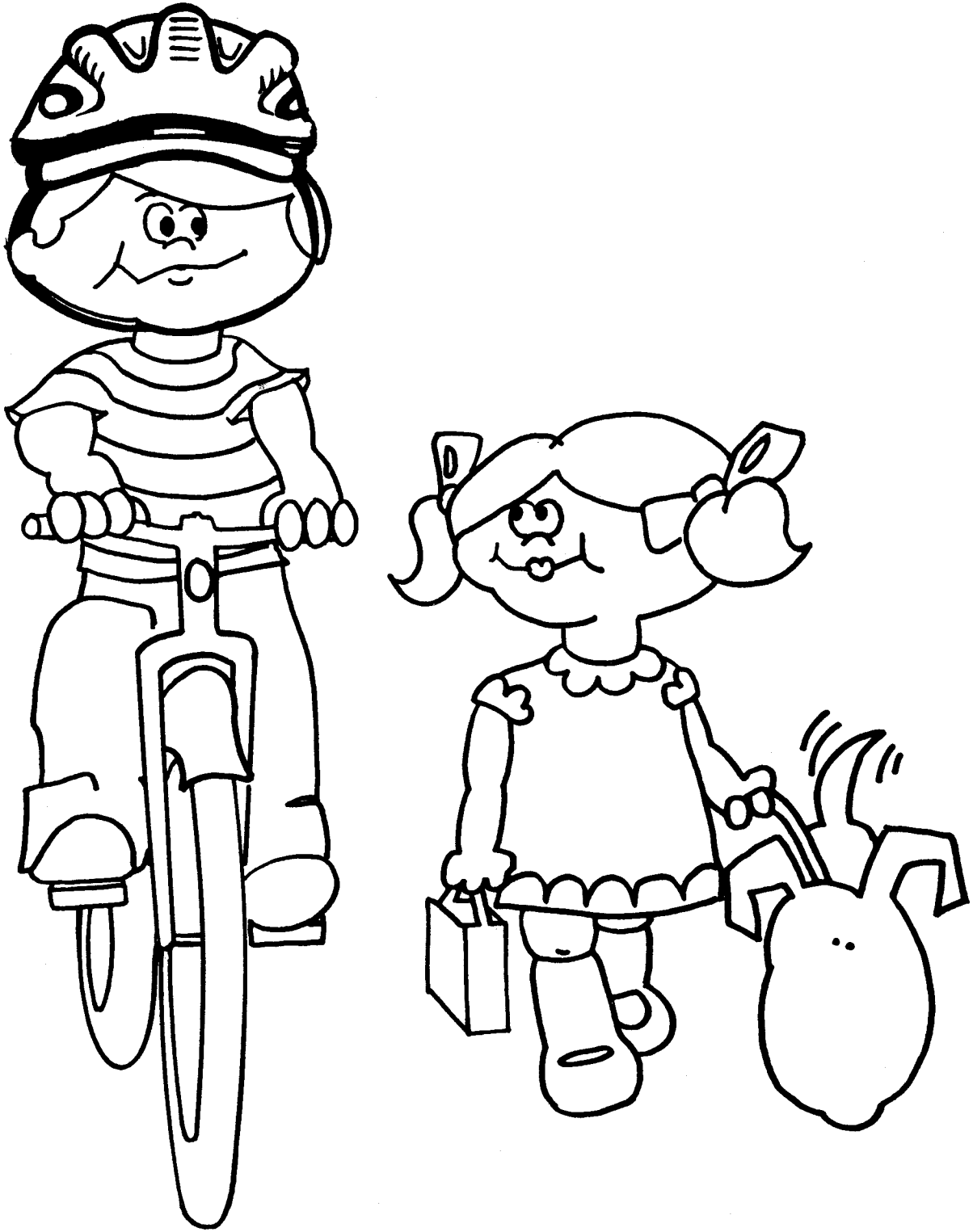
This sign means drivers should stop...



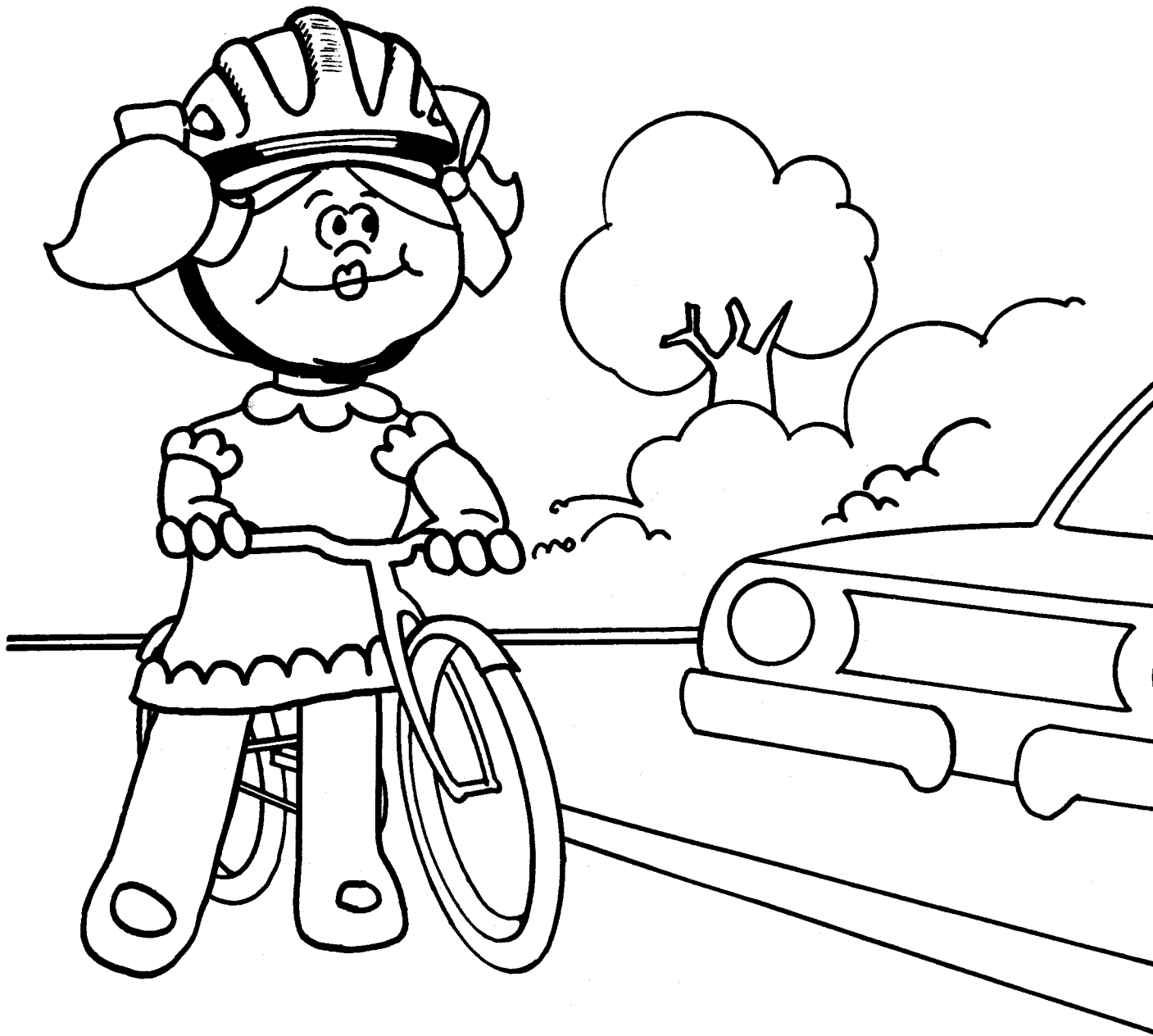
...and let you cross the street.



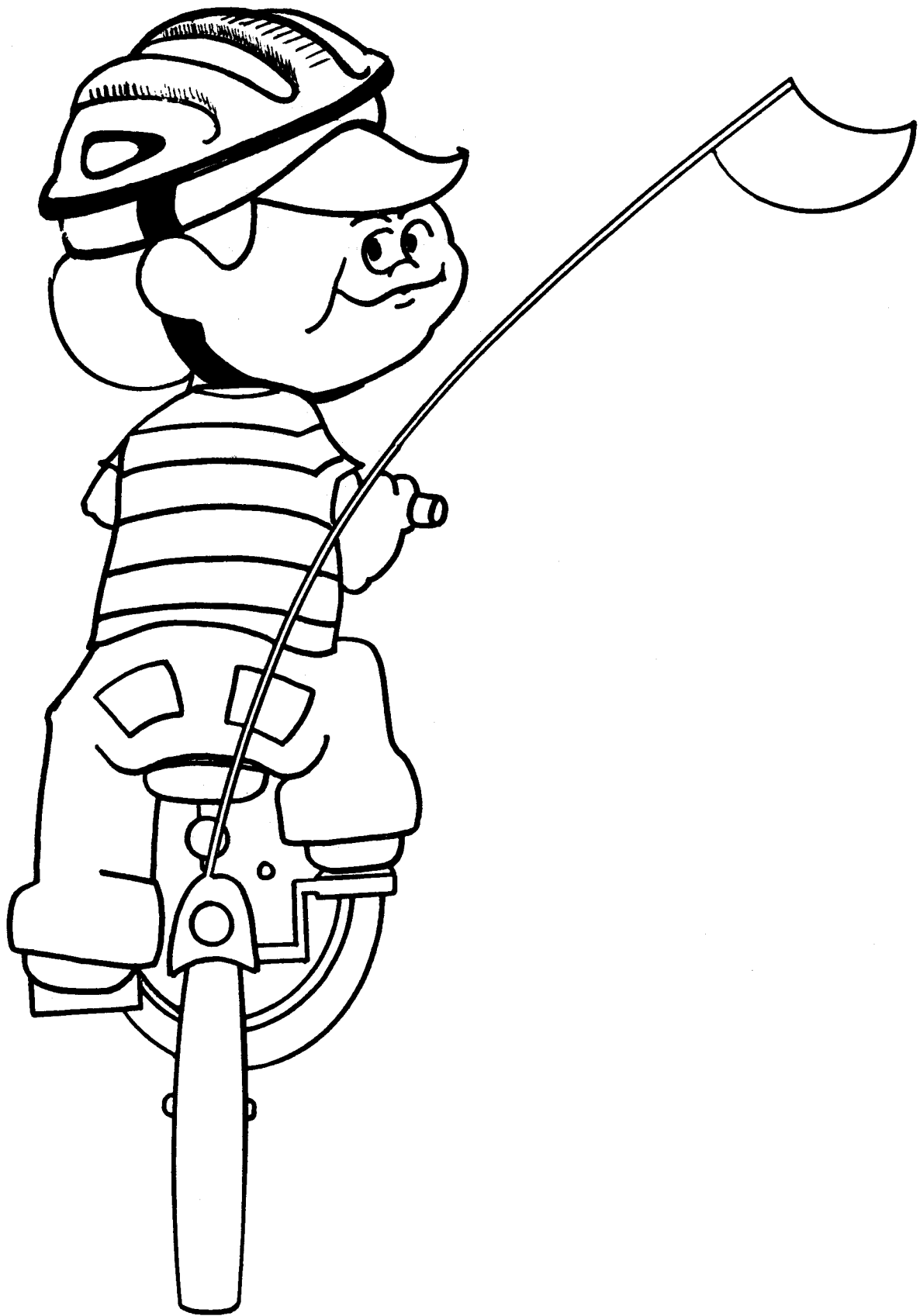
Wearing light colors at night
