

Housing for All: 6 Month Update

Of \$500 million dollars committed in the strategy, \$150 million has been committed towards these initiatives in our first 6 months.

- Rapid Rural Workforce Housing Pilot
- Extending Permanent Spike Protection Mechanism
- Enhance Tenant and Landlord Relations Services
- Preconstruction Funding To Support Housing
- Launch New Brunswick Public Universities Student Housing On-Campus Fund
- Make Government Surplus Property Available for Affordable Housing Development
- Launch Direct to Tenant Rental Benefit
- Spend \$100 million over 3 years to build 380 new public housing units
- Enhance Delivery of Housing Programs
- Increase Supply of Skilled Trades Professionals
- Create a Path Forward for Regional Transportation
- Establish a Small Community Housing Infrastructure Fund
- Engage with the New Brunswick Non-Profit Housing Association to Increase Capacity for Development
- Launch Preliminary Guidelines for Housing Needs Assessments
- A Working Group to Identify Development Barriers
- Invest \$192 million over 3 years to Upkeep Current Housing Stock
