

Notice of Appeal

Registry of Agricultural Land and Farm Land Identification Program



Right to Appeal a Decision: Any person who does not agree with a decision of the Registrar may file an appeal with the Farm Land Identification Appeal Board by serving upon it within sixty days of receiving the decision, written notice stating the matter in dispute to be determined by the Board. Every notice of appeal must contain a statement of the matter being appealed, property identification information, and the name and address of the person making the appeal.

I (we), owner(s) of the real property described by the Property Account Number (PAN) and Parcel Identification Number(s) (PID) listed below, disagree with a decision of the Registrar. I (we) have discussed the details surrounding the decision with the Registrar or his representative, and hereby request that an appeal hearing be held before the Farm Land Identification Program / Registry of Agricultural Land Appeal Board. I (we) understand that I (we) must serve this written notice upon the appeal Board not more than sixty days after I (we) received notice of the decision.
