NOTICE OF APPEAL COURT FILE NO. 111-17-CA

The Appellant Her Majesty the Queen is represented by the Attorney General of New Brunswick.

Date of judgment is September 7, 2017.

Place of trial was Moncton, New Brunswick, Provincial Court.

The charge was: "On or about April 25, 2016 in the City of Moncton, Province of New Brunswick, Jeffrey Curran did commit an aggravated assault on Cory Norris by wounding him, committing an indictable offence contrary to s. 268 of the *Criminal Code*."

The Appellant appeals against the acquittal pursuant to section 676(1)(a) of the *Criminal Code* on a question of law alone and will ask this Court to allow the appeal, set aside the acquittal and order a new trial pursuant to section 686(4)(b)(i) of the *Criminal Code*.

The grounds of appeal are: "The trial judge erred in law in his interpretation and application of the self-defence provisions set out in the *Criminal Code* at s. 34."

Pursuant to an Order for Substituted Service issued by a Justice of the New Brunswick Court of Appeal on October 31, 2017, service of this Notice of Appeal will be effective as of December 6, 2017.
