

COVID-19 Travel Isolation

Quick Reference Guide

I registered my travel at gnb.ca/travelregistration / 1-833-948-2800

My travel to NB has been approved and I am a:

- Non-essential traveller (funerals, weddings, shopping trips, vacations, etc.)
- Non-essential international traveller
- Person moving to NB permanently or for school
- Non-resident of NB coming to work in NB (without approved WorkSafeNB plan)
- NB resident returning to NB after working in another jurisdiction (except rotational workers, truckers or commuters and those approved under a WorkSafe NB isolation plan)
- NB post-secondary student (and resident accompanying them) returning from outside Atlantic Canada
- NB post-secondary student returning from an Atlantic COVID-19 hot zone

You will be required to **isolate in a designated isolation facility***. The Canadian Red Cross will be able to support you and answer any questions related to how this works.

Press "1" – Affected by Disaster
Press "5" – New Brunswick
Press "1" – Affected by COVID-19
Press "2" – NB Isolation Facility Support Line for Non-Essential Travellers

1. You will be required to isolate for at least 7 days (depending on test results) in an isolation facility at your own expense. **The cost of the isolation facility and related costs are your responsibility unless you are a student. Costs for the student only can be covered by the Province.**
2. On Day 5 of facility isolation, you can get tested. Results are usually returned by day 7. When you receive a negative test result, you can finish the remainder of your 14-day isolation at home or another location as long as there is no one else in the household except the person/people you travelled with and on condition that you get tested again on Day 10.
3. Transportation to designated isolation facility:
 - You must drive yourself or travel by taxi
 - No pickups from non-travellers
 - No carpools

- Regular cross-border commuter
- Trucker

Follow Modified Isolation requirements

- Rotational workers
- NB student returning from school in Atlantic Canada (*NOT COVID-19 hot zone*)

Follow Home Isolation requirements

- Person crossing the border for child custody/care
- NB resident returning after medical care
- Operator of commercial air, rail, marine
- NB resident returning after accessing urgent or specialized veterinary care
- Resident of Campobello Island

Obey all Public Health guidelines

*There may be individual cases that require an alternative to a specific hotel as a designated facility, such as a stand-alone residence. That will be determined on a case-by-case basis.
