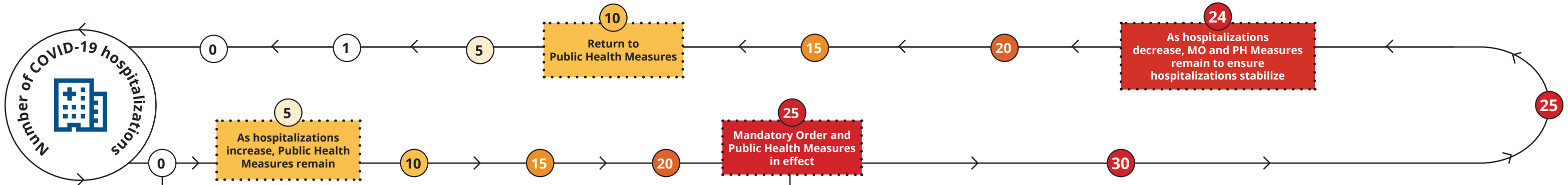


Public Health Measures and Mandatory Order Regulations

Measures and triggers in response to increasing COVID-19 hospitalizations



Public Health Measures

Masks

- Required in all indoor public places

Proof of full vaccination

- Patrons 12 and older required to show proof of full vaccination or medical exemption for access to some events, services and businesses

Travel registration

- Every person entering NB must pre-register travel. This includes New Brunswickers re-entering the province. The requirement to register travel and self-isolate if not fully vaccinated does not apply to:
 - Commercial truck drivers entering or re-entering NB for the purpose of delivering goods
 - Individuals accessing medical care not available in New Brunswick
 - Individuals employed by a business with workplace vaccination policy (vaccinated or regular testing and masking for all employees)
 - Custody agreements
 - Individuals travelling to access childcare or attend school (K-12)



Mandatory Order

All Public Health Measures will remain in effect under the Mandatory Order

- Masks, proof of full vaccination, travel registration

Private gatherings

- Indoor gathering with household plus 20 consistent contacts
 - Does not apply to businesses, such as restaurants, where patrons must show proof of full vaccination or medical exemption
- Outside gathering no limits, with physical distancing

Businesses and events where people gather or exercise:

Museums, cinemas, theatres, bingo halls, casinos, amusement centres, arenas, game rooms, pool halls, live entertainment venues, libraries, weddings, funerals, gyms, yoga studios, restaurants, bars and similar venues

- Businesses must demonstrate all employees are fully vaccinated or employees are continuously masked and regularly tested.
- Businesses can find out how to access rapid tests for their employees by contacting their local Chamber of Commerce.

Faith venues

- Ensure all participants show proof of full vaccination and continuously wear masks **or**
- Must operate at 50% capacity, maintain two metres of physical distancing between different households, continuously wear masks, record names of all attendees or have assigned seating, no singing and prevent anyone displaying COVID-19 symptoms or who has been instructed to self-isolate from entering.

Physical distancing

- Required when proof of full vaccination is not needed to enter a business, event or service (i.e. retail, grocery, private business, etc.)
