

VIVE Awards CATEGORY: GOVERNMENT CHAMPION



Eligibility:

A New Brunswick woman, women, Two Spirit, nonbinary, or gender diverse person(s). When we say New Brunswick women, we include everyone who identifies as a woman living in the province, regardless of sex assigned at birth, citizenship, or residency status. There is typically one award per category. The following descriptions serve to give guidance to the nominators.

GOVERNMENT CHAMPION

The government champion is someone who demonstrates a steadfast commitment to policy changes that empower women and/or gender diverse people. They may work for a government institution or agency (including healthcare and education), crown corporation, military, and law enforcement. They may be a politician, elected official, public servant, or researcher. Their leadership may ensure diverse representation in decision-making roles. They may allocate resources to address gender-based disparities or foster inclusive programs. Through partnerships and collaboration, they drive progress in the province. Their work may amplify underrepresented voices or address intersectional challenges.
