Class 1 Air Quality Operating Approval issued under the *Clean Air Act*

Effective August 14, 2020, the *Interim Summary of Issues and Responses*, as well as a draft approval is available regarding the renewal of the Approval to Operate for the Lake Utopia pulp and paper mill located approximately 6.5 km east of the town of St. George, New Brunswick.

Please note that the "Interim Summary" takes into consideration comments which were received by August 1st. This is also a reminder that the 120-day public comment period regarding this facility ends on October 13.
