1. Publish notice of registration in the local/regional newspaper, the Telegraph Journal.
2. Project information letter to Members of Legislative Assembly (MLAs) for Hampton and Quispamsis.

3. Project information letter to local governments, Hampton Local Service District (LSD) and Town of Quispamsis.
4. Distribute Project information flyer to local residents (via mailbox) and post flyers in local community. Area for distribution to include approximately 180 local residences within about 2.5 km of the proposed site along Route 860, Stock Farm Road, Porter Road, Old Road, MacKinnon Drive, and Duffy Lane.
5. Make copies of the registration supporting documents available in the Region 4 (Saint John) office of NBDELG, and Quispamsis Town Hall and one local public library. Digital copies will also be available upon request via email.

The proposed quarry will require a Mining Lease Approval under the *Mining Act*, and an Approval to Operate (Approval of a Source), under the *Clean Air Act*, in addition to the required environmental review under the EIA Regulation, *Clean Environment Act*.
