- The Federal Guaranteed Income Supplement (GIS) during 2021 (must be 65 years or older) or
- the Federal Allowance for the Survivor during 2021 (must be between 60-64 years old) or
- the Federal Allowance during 2021 (must be between 60-64 years old).

Important: Persons in receipt of a Federal allowance who are under the age of 60 do not qualify for this benefit.
