57% were females

Median age:

51 years

Paramedics gave naloxone to **238** people
110 (46%) people responded to naloxone



50% males

21% were
40 to 49 years old

What is Naloxone?

It is a drug that stops the harmful effects of opioids, but it has no effect on its own
