

Dr. Constantine Passaris Third initiative: publish a book

The third initiative was, we wanted a tangible reminder of this year, 1992, and we thought a compilation of essays from different experts and practitioners and advocates of human rights collected in a book would be the best gift that we could leave behind in terms of this anniversary. And indeed, Professor John McEvoy and I established a list of various people around the province, and they wrote essays on human rights. We entitled the book *Human Rights in New Brunswick - A New Vision for a New Century*. The book was published in New Brunswick's two official languages: English and French. Up until then, everything was going fine until we ran out of money. So the New Brunswick Law Foundation stepped up to the plate and provided us with the cost of publishing the book, and that's the look that was the result of that third initiative of the anniversary year.
