

## Crown Reserve Party Chief

Crown Reserve Party Chiefs serve as the primary contact between members of a Crown Reserve angling party and the Department of Energy and Resource Development. Their responsibilities include:

- Submitting an application on behalf of other Crown Reserve party members. As part of the application process Party Chiefs must obtain the necessary application information from party members and ensure that party members meet eligibility requirements to angle on Crown Reserve.
- Payment of party member application and licence fees at the time of the Crown Reserve application or licence purchase.
- Distribution of Crown Reserve angling licences to members of the angling party.
- Making party member substitution requests.
- Completing and submitting the Crown Reserve Creel census form to the Department of Energy and Resource Development following the completion of the angling trip.
