

SCOPE OF THE OCCUPATION

The automotive painter occupation includes

- (a) the preparing of metal surfaces for painting;
- (b) the applying of sealers and refinishing products;
- (c) the cleaning and polishing of painted surfaces;
- (d) the cleaning of upholstery;
- (e) the removing and replacing of decals;
- (f) the interpreting of vehicle information, work orders, technical manuals and bulletins;
- (g) the contributing of the development of repair estimates;
- (h) the using of computers and measuring equipment; and
- (i) the preparing and maintaining of spray booths and spray equipment.
