

SCOPE OF THE OCCUPATION

The construction craft worker occupation includes

- (a) the handling of construction materials, using and maintaining tools and equipment, organizing work, interpreting basic blueprints and performing routine activities related to the occupation;
- (b) the preparing, cleaning and monitoring of sites, performing basic demolition and ground work, performing safety watches;
- (c) the using of scaffolding and access equipment;
- (d) the assisting with shoring, setting up and dismantling of formwork for concrete;
- (e) the placing and assisting with finishing of concrete, modified concrete, assisting with the installation of grout, epoxies and caulking;
- (f) the preparing for masonry work and tending of bricklayers;
- (g) the installing of utility piping and performing pipeline activities; and
- (h) the installing of paving materials and roadwork components.
