
Occupations designated as compulsory under section 56 of the Apprenticeship and Occupational Certification Act are prescribed by regulation by the Lieutenant Governor in Council. The Board may make an order exempting a person or class of persons from the application of one or more of the tasks, activities or functions of a compulsory occupation as prescribed by regulation.

Persons or class of persons laying bricks, blocks, stones, tiles, glass blocks and other building materials to construct retaining walls, piers, patios, steps and other similar installations for outdoor landscape applications are exempt from the compulsory requirements of the Bricklayer occupation.
