
Occupations designated as compulsory under section 56 of the *Apprenticeship and Occupational Certification Act* are prescribed by regulation by the Lieutenant Governor in Council. The Board may make an order exempting a person or class of persons from the application of one or more of the tasks, activities or functions of a compulsory occupation as prescribed by regulation.

- Persons or class of persons who hold a valid license issued under the *Boiler and Pressure Vessel Act* and the work being performed comes within the scope of that license are exempt from the compulsory requirement of the Construction Boilermaker occupation.
- Persons or class of persons who hold a certificate of qualification issued under the *Apprenticeship and Occupational Certification Act* in an occupation where the work to be performed comes within the scope of that other designated occupation are exempt from the compulsory requirements of the Construction Boilermaker occupation.
- Persons or class of persons performing the routine maintenance and repairing of boilers, heat exchangers and related equipment required for the day-to-day operations of in-plant facilities are exempt from the compulsory requirement of the Construction Boilermaker occupation.
