Occupations designated as compulsory under section 56 of the Apprenticeship and Occupational Certification Act are prescribed by regulation by the Lieutenant Governor in Council. The Board may make an order exempting a person or class of persons from the application of one or more of the tasks, activities or functions of a compulsory occupation as prescribed by regulation.

- Persons or class of persons performing the removal, replacement and addition of sheet metal systems and components within existing facilities are exempt from the compulsory requirements of the Sheet Metal Worker occupation.
- Persons or class of persons performing the routine maintenance and repairing of sheet metal system required by the day-to-day operations of in-plant facilities are exempt from the compulsory requirements of the Sheet Metal Worker occupation.
