

APPRENTICESHIP AND OCCUPATIONAL CERTIFICATION

Board Order

This is an order of the New Brunswick Apprenticeship and Occupational Certification Board made pursuant to section 14 of the Apprenticeship and Occupational Certification Act.

Occupations designated as compulsory under section 56 of the *Apprenticeship and Occupational Certification Act* are prescribed by regulation by the Lieutenant Governor in Council. The Board may make an order exempting a person or class of persons from the application of one or more of the tasks, activities or functions of a compulsory occupation as prescribed by regulation.

- Persons or class of persons performing the rigging, installing, altering, maintaining, repairing and testing of piping and related piping components and equipment used in non-potable systems to used to convey low and high pressure steam, hot water, air, gases, fluids or any other substance in the day-to-day operations in in-plant facilities are exempt from the compulsory requirements of the Steamfitter-Pipefitter occupation.
- Persons or class of persons performing the rigging, installing, altering, maintaining, repairing and testing of piping and related piping components and equipment used in non-potable systems to used to convey low and high pressure steam, hot water, air, gases, fluids or any other substance assembled or installed during the manufacture of equipment prior to delivery to a building, structure or site are exempt from the compulsory requirements of the Steamfitter-Pipefitter occupation.
