

SCOPE OF THE OCCUPATION

The ironworker (generalist) occupation includes

- (a) the erecting, dismantling and repairing or replacing of structural steel components, bridges, tanks, bins and hoppers;
- (b) the erecting and dismantling of pre-cast and pre-stressed concrete;
- (c) the erecting, dismantling, maintaining, repairing or replacing of machinery and equipment.
- (d) the installing of concrete reinforcing materials;
- (e) the installing of curtain walls, ornamental and miscellaneous ironwork;
- (f) the rigging of structural steel components, bridges, tanks, bins and hoppers.
- (g) the rigging of machinery and heavy equipment;
- (h) the erecting and installing of electric overhead travelling cranes;
- (i) the edge preparation, tacking and cutting of metals (ferrous and non-ferrous);
- (j) the selecting, erecting and dismantling of scaffolding; and
- (k) the interpreting of blueprints and symbols.
