

SCOPE OF THE OCCUPATION

The staker-detailer occupation includes

- (a) the providing of design assistance, surveying and staking of overhead or underground distribution lines, or both;
- (b) the detailing and estimating of capital and maintenance work for distribution plant;
- (c) the detailing and estimating of tree trimming and right of way clearing requirements;
- (d) the detailing and preparing of the documentation necessary for preparation of job work orders;
- (e) the visiting of job sites to review problems encountered or deviations from the original project plan;
- (f) the maintaining of liaisons with governmental and non-governmental agencies and the general public regarding the job function;
- (g) the obtaining of permission from property owners for placement of a distribution plant; and
- (h) the maintaining of a knowledge of legislative and other standards affecting the design, engineering, construction and maintenance of distribution lines and plant.
