As of September 1st, 2022, under Section 11 (a) of the Electrical

Installation and Inspection Act Chapter 144, the edition of the Code adopted under Section 2 of Regulation 84- 165, is "CSA Standard C22.1-21, Canadian Electrical Code Part I (25<sup>th</sup> Edition) Safety Standard for Electrical Installations.

Amendments to Code rules are detailed in section 2 of Regulation 84-165. (Listed below)

<u>Effective December 1st, 2022</u>, all electrical installations and electrical designs in New Brunswick shall be completed in full compliance with the 2021 Canadian Electrical Code.

<u>Prior to December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022</u>, electrical installations may be completed at the option of the permit holder under the 2018 *OR* the 2021 Canadian Electrical Code edition provided that the electrical plans, where applicable, have been accepted by Technical Inspection Services and a permit covering the installation has been issued prior to December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022.

Technical Inspection Services reserves the right to determine whether electrical work has in fact commenced on any installation prior to December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022.

- 1) Section 2 of New Brunswick Regulation 84-165 under the Electrical Installation and Inspection Act is amended
- (a) in the definition "Code"
- (i) in the portion preceding paragraph (a) by striking out "C22.1-18, Canadian Electrical Code, Part I (24th Edition)," and substituting
- "C22. 1-21, Canadian Electrical Code, Part I, (25th Edition)".
- (ii) in paragraph (b.2) by striking out "Rule 26-712) (e)" and substituting "Rule 26-724 (e)".
- (b) in the definition "emergency repair" by adding after paragraph (b) the following:
- (b.1) a meter-mounting device.
- (c) in paragraph (d) of the definition "type III installation" by striking out "48,52 or 68" and substituting "52,64 or 68".
- 2) Subsection 16(5.2) of the Regulation is amended by repealing the portion preceding paragraph (a) and substituting the following:
- 16(5.2) When it is not possible for a wiring permit or special wiring permit to be issued before an electrical contractor carries out an emergency repair, the electrical contractor may undertake to carry out the emergency repair without first obtaining the wiring permit or special wiring permit if the electrical contractor...
- 3) Section 21 of the Regulation is amended in the portion preceding paragraph
  - (a) by striking out "alteration and extension" and substituting "maintenance and alteration".
- 4) This Regulation comes into effect September 1,2022.
