Comments: The requirement to obtain a kennel licence in Regulation 84-85 under the *Municipalities Act* has been repealed. Kennels are now licensed pursuant to Regulation 2010-74, the *Pet Establishment Regulation* of the *Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act.*
