Comments: *This regulation replaces licensing currently required pursuant to subsection 4(3) of N.B. Regulation 84-85, the *Provincial Dog Regulation - Municipalities Act* and pet establishment licences required by municipal by-laws enacted pursuant to sections 95.1 and 96 of the *Municipalities Act*. Currently, only kennel licences are required; the new regulation will require that kennels and pet retail stores be licensed as pet establishments as defined in regulation.

** Revenue collected from this licence fee is anticipated to be \$50,000 annually, but will not increase revenue to the Province as it will be deposited into the Animal Protection Account for use by the New Brunswick Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals.
