<p><b>Comments:</b> *Currently, a licence is required for dogs located in areas outside the territorial limits of a municipality and in rural communities that have not enacted a by-law under subsection 96(1) of the <i>Municipalities Act</i>. The current licence fee is \$10 for a female dog and \$5 for a male dog or a spayed female dog. One \$15 fee will replace the existing fee amounts.</p> <p>** Revenue collected from this licence fee is anticipated to be \$26,000 annually, but will not increase revenue to the Province as it will be deposited into the Animal Protection Account for use by the New Brunswick Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals.</p>
