<b>Comments:</b> The regulatory charges associated with the Freshwater Aquaculture Certificate of Approval (freshwater site having at least 25,000 finfish but fewer than 200,000) are designed to recover the costs of drafting approvals and ensuring compliance through site inspections and regular communication with clients. This change is being proposed based on increases in departmental costs related to this industry and to the application of the <i>Clean Environment Act</i> .
