Comments: The purpose of the licence is to ensure that all work is conducted in accordance with the act and regulation, so as to prevent petroleum spills and contamination. Licences must be renewed on an annual basis. This regulatory charge is designed to recover the costs of reviewing applications and associated documentation, and the issuance of licences. The increase in fees is proposed based on increasing costs to deliver the program.
