<b>Comments:</b> This annual regulatory charge is designed to recover the costs of administering the approvals program, which consists of an application review, approval development and issuance, compliance verification, data management and the possibility of emergency responses. The actual time spent on providing these services increases with facility complexity and associated environmental risk. The proposed fee change is commensurate with increasing costs in administering this program.
