<b>Comments:</b> This regulatory charge is designed to recover the costs of issuing approvals according to the Guideline for the Site Selection, Operation and Approval of Composting Facilities in New Brunswick, including technical reviews of proposed sites, audits, records maintenance and inspections. This includes approval of composting facilities processing exclusively organic matter, other than domestic solid waste or domestic wastewater biosolids, which process 3,000 cubic metres or more of such organic matter per year. This fee change is being proposed based on increased costs to deliver the program.
