Comments: Septage haulers are required to have an Approval to Operate a Septage Handling Business, which includes cesspools, domestic septic tanks, domestic holding tanks, chemical toilets, portable toilets, vault privies and marina sewage pump-out facilities. The department reviews applications and issues approvals, and reviews Annual Septage Handling Reports that each contractor is required to submit. The increase to this regulatory charge is proposed based on increasing costs to deliver the program.
