Comments : There are currently two site categories for video lottery site holders in New Brunswick. They are: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Category 1: 15-25 video lottery terminals (VLT), initial registration fee of \$3,200, yearly renewal fee of \$3,000 • Category 2: 1-10 VLTs, initial registration fee of \$1,200 and yearly renewal of \$1,000 The proposed fee is for a new category of VLT sites, category three, which would have between 10 and 14 VLTs. The proposed initial registration fee is \$2,200 with a yearly renewal fee of \$2,000. The new site category will benefit site holders with the opportunity to “right-size” the number of VLTs in their business.
