<p><b>Comments:</b> Excepting for the addition of annual over-mass permits in 2009; NB regulation 89-65, fees for Special Move Permits have not been adjusted since 2004. This amendment is made to respective sections of <i>NB regulation 89-65</i>, for the purpose of adjusting the special permit fees respective to the increased costs associated with the issuance of special move permits. All fee increases are based on the 2020 consumer price index (CPI). The adjustment of fees will be phased in over a three-year period, at a rate of 10% annually, commencing on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of December 2022, with the last adjustment occurring on the 1<sup>st</sup> of December 2024.</p> <p>Phase one will also include: the addition of vehicle permits approved under the DTI Strategic Corridor and Highway Upgrading Programs, and the removal of all references to the expired NB regulation 83-42</p>
