The New Brunswick’s Heritage Fair Program is a provincial initiative of the Archaeology and Heritage Branch of the Department of Tourism, Heritage and Culture to celebrate and promote the diversity of New Brunswick and Canadian cultural and natural heritage through research.

The HERITAGE FAIR is a competition where the students (grade 5 to 9) are encouraged to explore their heritage by choosing a subject of interest relating to heritage and conduct research using a variety of historical sources. The most well-researched and best-presented projects will pass to the regional level.

- The fairs may be undertaken by an entire school, a class, in small groups or individually.
- The fairs may take place in the classroom, in the school, in the community or in another setting.
- The fairs happen during the school year between mid-February and mid-April.

Beginning of May to mid-May	Period for district Regional Heritage Fairs
<i>Right after the Regional Fairs</i>	Regional Coordinator will contact the Provincial coordinator and share the presentation videos of the Laureates of the Provincial Showcase Awards
Mid-June	Provincial Heritage Fair Ceremony , where the students will present their project to the honorary patron, the Lieutenant Governor.

SECTION 4 – SIGNATURE

Your school can receive a grant of \$250 after hosting a school fair. An additional \$250 will be given to help with the transportation of the students to the Regional Heritage Fair. To receive the money, we will ask you to complete and submit a **final report** to send to the Provincial Coordinator before April 30th, 2023. The payment will be sent by either a cheque or direct deposit prior to the end of the school year. Please make sure to fill in Section 1 concerning the school information to ensure a faster processing time.
