

Public Advisory

The Department of Transportation and Infrastructure advises the travelling public that work on the Route 15/Harrisville Boulevard interchange project will necessitate a lane closure on the Harrisville Boulevard bridge. The lane closure will take effect on Sunday, April 1 and continue until further notice.

For the duration of the lane closure, a number of traffic restrictions will be in place.

Northbound traffic on Harrisville Boulevard, heading towards Kent Building Supplies, will not be able to turn left on to Route 15.

Southbound traffic on Harrisville Boulevard, heading towards Dieppe, will not be able to turn left on to Route 15.

Westbound traffic on Route 15, heading towards Moncton, will not be able to exit on to the Harrisville Boulevard exit ramp.

Eastbound traffic on Route 15, heading towards the Route 2 interchange, will be able to take the exit ramp and turn right towards Dieppe but will not be able to turn left on to Harrisville Boulevard.

Traffic detour signs will be in place in order to direct traffic. The Department of Transportation and Infrastructure regrets any inconvenience this may cause and appreciates the public's patience and cooperation as we work on this project, which will improve traffic flow in the area.
